Wyoming Youth State USBC Championship Tournament Rules



November $4^{th} - 5^{th} & 11^{th} - 12^{th}, 2017$

- 1. Entrant must be a 2017-2018 Wyoming sanctioned USBC bowler prior to the start of this tournament or submit a letter of verification from the local secretary if membership is in progress.
- 2. AGE as of August 1, 2017 shall be used to classify bowlers.

Class 3-----ages 11 and under Team Event: Consists of four youth bowlers any sex

Class 2----ages 12 through 14 Doubles: Consists of two youth bowlers any sex
Class 1----ages 15 and older Singles: Consists of one youth bowler

All classes shall bowl three games in each event. Combined age groups will be classed by the oldest member of the team or double. Singles and All-Events entrants will be classed by the individual's sex and age.

- 3. Bowlers who bowl in the <u>doubles event must also bowl in the singles event and vice-versa.</u> Doubles bowling together should send entries and fees in the same envelope. If you ask the Tournament Director to help provide a bowler for either team or doubles <u>you must include the money for that bowler.</u> Bowlers may enter only once in each event. In the event of an emergency, when a substitute cannot be found, the tournament director may at their discretion allow a bowler to bowl a second time to fill the spot of the missing bowler.
- 4. Averages used will be taken in the following order.
 - #1 Highest WY USBC 2016/2017 final sanctioned league average with a minimum of 12 games. (This is to include any regular season league, travel league and/or summer leagues that are sanctioned.)
 - #2 Highest WY USBC 2017/2018 sanctioned league average as of October 29, 2017 with a minimum of 9 games.
 - #3 If a bowler does not fill the requirements of Rule #1 or Rule #2 then he/she will bowl scratch.
- 5. All averages will be verified by the State Youth Tournament Director and/or Agent of USBC.
- 6. Entries with payment must be postmarked by October 22, 2017. Late entries are at the discretion of the tournament director.
- 7. Falsification of any average/or age may result in the disqualification of the bowler to include singles, doubles, team and allevents. This could also result in the disqualification for partners in doubles and or team events.
- 8. Handicap awards ratio shall be at least 1 to 10. All awards will be returned 100%. Symbolic awards will be given to the highest Scratch and Handicap- Team, Doubles, Singles and All-Events in each class. Awards for ties will be duplicated. (Ex.- Ties for 2nd place; two 2nd places will be awarded and next award will be for 4th place.)
- 9. All USBC Youth Tournament rules and regulations will be governed by USBC in any situation not covered herein.
- 10. No late frames shall be allowed. A bowler must start bowling in the frame he/she arrives, and will not receive a score for the frames missed. NO BLIND SCORES WILL BE ALLOWED. A bowler must be ready to bowl when it is his/her turn, or they will receive a zero for those frames. In case of an emergency, let the tournament director and scorekeeper know of the situation.
- 11. Team and Doubles shall bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Subs must take the place of the bowler they are replacing. No rearranging of partners will be permitted. Subs may change the age class.
- 12. All entrants must report 30 minutes before assigned time. Any changes and/or subs are to be made at least ONE (1) hour before assigned squad time by the team captain or coach. It is still the teams responsibility to find their sub if at all possible.
- 13. Handicap is 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220 for each age class.

14. Entry fees are \$25.00 per event:

*Optional Jr. Gold Qualifier:

\$15.00 Lineages/Expenses

Must have Jr. Gold membership prior to bowling.

\$10.00 Awards

Fee to be paid at check-in prior to the first event bowled.

\$25.00 Total entry fee (per person/per event)

Based on scratch all-events scores (Boy/Girl/Age division)

- 15. Youth bowling all three events are automatically entered into scratch and handicap all-events without additional fees.
- 16. After entries have been received, any refund requests will be up to the discretion of the tournament committee.
- 17. Any appeal or protest regarding scores or eligibility shall be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of completion of the tournament.
- 18. Entry must be paid in full by cashier check, business check or money order. Make payment to Wyoming Youth USBC, No personal checks will be accepted.
- 19. **Confirmation letters will not be mailed out but rather posted on the <u>www.bowlwyo.com</u> website. It will be the bowlers responsibility to verify bowling dates and times.**
