- 1. Tournament is certified by USBC and will be governed by USBC rules, Certification #XXXX.
- 2. Entrant must be a Wyoming USBC Youth member under the age of 18 as of August 1, 2021 to participate.
- 3. One time entry. If a bowler advances out of a league level in more than one state/province/zone, the bowler must declare one state/province/zone, to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state/province/zone will result in automatic disqualification.
- 4. Advancement ratios from league to state are at least 1 for every 1 in all divisions.
- 5. Entries with payment must be postmarked by February 12, 2022. Late entries/Refunds are at the discretion of the tournament director.
- 6. There will be 5 divisions offered based on date of birth:

U8 - 8/1/13 or Later U10 - 8/1/11 - 7/31/13 U12 - 8/1/09 - 7/31/11 U15 - 8/1/06 - 7/31/09 U18 - 8/1/03 - 7/31/06

- All U12, U15, U18 divisions will have both a boys & girls divisions. Depending on the number of entries U8 & U10 divisions may be combined into one division by age and/or boy/girl by the discretion of the tournament director
- 7. Format: U8, U10 and U12 will bowl a 3 game block to determine scholarship winners. Ages U15, and U18 will bowl a 6 game qualifier on Saturday, March 5th. The top 6 in the U15 and U18 divisions will bowl 6 games on Sunday, March 6th. A sport oil pattern will be used for all competition. All qualifying scores are dropped from Saturdays qualifying. Total pins on Sunday will determine the winners.

- 9. Bowlers must wear appropriate attire. No alcohol or tobacco is allowed in the center by anyone during the youth competition.
- 10. Bowlers arriving late will begin play at that time. Their score will count beginning with the frame being bowled. Frames missed will be credited with a zero. A bowler that is not ready to bowl when it is his/her turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
- 11. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the settee area.
- 12. Ties will be broken for the U12, U15, U18 divisions by a one game roll off. Should a tie still exist, an additional 9th and 10th frame will be bowled until the tie is broken.
- 13. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after completion of the tournament, whichever comes first. The tournament director will decide upon questionable errors. All other protest must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours or before the awards are given out. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
- 14. Scholarship will be given with a ratio of at least 1 to 10 as per rule 308C in all divisions. A sweatshirt/jacket will be presented to the winners of each division at the Annual State Jamboree in September.
- 15. The first place winner in the U12, U15 and U18 divisions, both boys and girls, can, at their own expense advance to the 2022 Junior Gold Championships in Grand Rapids, MI, July 15-23, 2022. Entry fee into this tournament is paid for by the Junior Gold Pepsi-Cola sponsorship. The advancers must be Junior Gold Program members, or be eligible and purchase a membership prior to registering for the Championships. Each athlete is required to bring a parent, guardian, or coach to the event as his/her supervisor.
- 16. Advancers must agree to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships, or to do so, agree to waive all rights. If a division champion is unwilling/unable to become a USBC Junior Gold Program Member, then they will not advance to the Championships. The athlete will still retain the State Scholarship, but the berth to the Championships will be awarded to the next eligible athlete. Replacements/alternates will incur all expenses with the exception of the entry fee for the Championship.
- 17. Scholarships awarded will be governed by the National SMART Fund. www.bowl.com/SMART
- 18. Failure to abide by any rules and regulations may lead to disqualification from the event. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations will be determined by the Wyoming Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Tournament Committee. The National Pepsi Youth Championship Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant. All decisions are final.
- 19. Confirmation letters will not be mailed out but rather posted on the www.bowlwyo.com website. It will be the bowlers' responsibility to verify their qualifying date and time.
