TWO BAR BOWL, CHEYENNE, WY
40 teams will be invited to state this year
Entries must be received by March 15, 2024

-
1. Team will be comprised of four (4) members: boys, girls, and/or mixed which have won the right to participate by their placement in their own travel league area.
 2. State teams are responsible for finding their own substitutes from the sub list or members of teams not participating at state. Substitutes must be reported at least 1 hour prior to scheduled time. Substitutes will have the right to pay the entry fee and receive any scholarship won if they wish to do so. If the regular member pays the entry fee, they will receive any scholarship won.
 3. Check-in time for all bowlers is at least ½ hour before scheduled time to bowl.
 4. Averages used for Saturday qualifier will be used in this order:
 - 1) 2023-2024 final travel league average with a minimum of 12 games.
 - 2) 2023-2024 regular league average as of March 1 with a minimum of 21 games.
 5. Handicap will be 90% of 220.
 6. Cost of state finals is \$40 per bowler (\$25 lineage, \$6 expenses, \$9 awards)
 7. No vacancy scores will be allowed.
 8. If an entire team does not attend, the opposing team members must bowl within 10 pins of their average and the team within 40 pins of total to earn points.
 9. Teams will be divided into 4 Sections (A, B, C, D) for the 5-game qualifier on Saturday.
 10. Each match consists of one (1) game with one (1) point awarded for each individual win and three (3) points for team win for a total of seven (7) possible points. Except for the first, each round within the section is a position round. Teams on odd lane will set lineup first, then team on right will enter theirs - after which lineup may not be modified for that game.
 11. Scholarships will be awarded to the members of the top three teams in each section.
 12. The top 5 teams from each section will advance to the finals on Sunday at 9am. Ties for advancement to finals will be settled by:
 - 1) Head to head match score
 - 2) Game 5 match score
 13. Substitutes on Sunday will be allowed ONLY in an emergency situation.
 14. Average for Sunday will be adjusted upward - but not downward - with the following formula: Saturday average minus entering average divided by 2; added to entering average. (ex: 160 Saturday average - 150 enter ÷ 2 added to entering average = 155 new Sunday average)
 15. Saturday qualifier points will be dropped. All 20 teams will bowl 6 games using the same point system as previously stated. Each round except the first is a position round.
 16. Tie for 1st place in Sunday finals will be determined by a one game roll-off. Ties for all other positions: scholarships will be added together and divided equally among the winners
 17. Awards will be returned 100% in scholarships with a ratio of at least 1 to 10.
