

#### **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- Tournament is certified by the USBC and will be governed by USBC rules, Sanction #07635. Entrant must be a USBC Youth member in good standing to participate.
- Tournament will be held at Family Fun Frontier Center, 5700 S Douglas Hwy, Gillette WY, 82718 on February 11, 2017 at 9:00 AM.
- 3. Entry Fee of \$45.00 (\$18.00 lineage, \$27.00 awards) must be paid prior to bowling. No personal checks will be accepted. Money orders or business checks should be made payable to Family Fun Frontier Center (FFFC).

- Entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the tournament if space is available. Entries will be limited to the first 80.
- Jr Gold Qualifier: For an additional fee of \$40.00 participants may enter to qualify for the Junior Gold Championships in Dallas, TX, July 14-21, 2018. One entry allowed. Advancement ratio will be 1:4. Separate qualifier for boys and girls in 6 age divisions based on the participant's date of birth: U12 (8/1/2005 or Later), U15 (8/1/2002-7/31/2005) U20 (8/1/1997-7/31/2002). If not enough entries in any division bowlers will be given the option to be combined with other divisions based on entries. Participants must be a Jr Gold member or purchase their membership prior to the start of the tournament.
- Participants will bowl 6 games, bowlers lined up on odd number lanes will skip one lane to the left and bowlers lined up on even number lanes will skip one lane to the right. All 6 games will be used to determine Jr Gold Qualifiers in each division. The bowlers with the top five overall scores will advance to the next round which will be a one game step ladder format: To be bowled on lanes 15 & 16 the fifth seed bowler will bowl the fourth seed bowler, winner of that match will bowl the third seed bowler and so on. Lanes 19 & 20 will be used to allow the top three place bowlers to warm up once match prior to them bowling begins.
- Bowlers must wear appropriate attire. No hats. No torn, ripped or frayed clothing. No short shorts. Skirts/skorts and Bermuda type shorts are allowed but no shorter than the length of your fingertips with arms at your side. No muscle shirts, tank tops or low cut shirts. Dress code will be strictly enforced. No alcohol or tobacco is allowed in the center by anyone during the youth competition.
- Check in will be 30 minutes prior to the start of the tournament. Bowlers arriving late will begin play at that time. Their score will count beginning with the frame being bowled. Frames missed will be credited with a zero. A bowler that is not ready to bowl when it is his/her turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
- 10. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the settee area. No food or drink in the settee area.
- Ties will be broken in all divisions by a one game roll off. Should a tie still exist, an additional 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame will be bowled until the tie is broken.
- 12. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than 30 minutes after completion of the tournament. The Tournament Director will decide upon questionable errors. All other protest must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours or before the awards are given out. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
- 13. Scholarship will be given with a ratio of at least 1 to 10 as per rule 308C in all divisions.
- Jr Gold qualifiers in all divisions, both boys and girls, can, at their own expense advance to the 2018 Junior Gold Championships in Dallas, TX, July 14-21, 2018. Each athlete will be required to bring a parent, guardian, or coach to the event as his or her supervisor.
- 15. Scholarships awarded will be governed by the National SMART Fund. www.bowl.com/SMART.
- Failure to abide by any rules and regulations may lead to disqualification from the event. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations will be determined by the Tournament Director. All decisions are final.
